

Community Engagement from September 2009

The following is a summary of the feedback from the September Consultation

- The buffer zone to the east of the village has been welcomed.
- Development is needed to sustain the village.
- The shop will close if it is not supported, new housing would help support the existing facilities.
- The primary school role is falling, new housing would support the school.
- There are a lot of positives in the Masterplan it will protect the character of the village.
- Parking in the centre of the village is essential for the pub, shop church and community hall.
- Any proposed enhancement of the square will have to retain substantial areas of parking and compensate for any parking removed elsewhere.
- There are mixed views on the link road and the impact on the roads within the village.
- The amount of open space proposed is about right.
- There is support for bringing the school into the centre of the village.
- The character and appearance of the proposed housing and primary school will be very important.
- The retention of important views of the church has been welcomed.

The proposed footpath network is popular.
